


Redbank Raptors

"Exciting, enthusiastic, engaging, energetic and really tall!" is how students often describe the fresh-faced Dr Cameron Stelzer, who has a Doctorate of Visual Arts as well as a graduate diploma in education. In primary school, Cameron

wrote many short stories for the local newspaper. After graduating from university he worked at the Natural History Museum in London and began writing stories inspired by the animals in the museum. When Cameron returned to Australia, he completed and released his first Stroogle adventure. Cameron has since written and illustrated six picture books, six Pie Rats novels and three how-to drawing books. Cameron's Pie Rats series have won numerous book awards internationally. The new spinoff series, *Scallywags*, will be released in mid-2018.



Cameron Stelzer author and illustrator is visiting Redbank on Monday 16 July 2018 (first day of Term 3) to conduct writing workshops with all students at Redbank over the whole day. Teachers have completed their workshop choices which include:-
