
Redbank Raptors

Each room in our school has a set of posters to remind the students of our behaviour expectations. The students will be learning about being safe, responsible and respectful by choosing their behaviour. **The behaviour lesson that the students are focussing on for weeks 3 and 4 is:** Use appropriate verbal and non-verbal language.

Major: The use of swear words or curse words directed towards others in a demeaning or provoking way. Repeated intentional use of inappropriate language.

Minor: Swearing or the use of curse words not directed at someone.

Use the Raptor 3 to prevent the escalation of incidents both in the classroom and in the playground. Make the right behavioural choice so that the learning and games of others is not affected.

PREP ENROLMENTS FOR 2019

Do you have a child eligible to enrol for Prep for 2019? They must be born between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014. Prep Information Day will be held on Wednesday 31 October.

We will offer 2 sessions, 9-10am OR 5-6 pm.

Contact the school office for any enquiries; if you are unable to come to the info day, enrolment packs will be available at the office shortly after the Information Day. **TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ENROLMENT**, you must provide a birth certificate, **OR** a letter from Centrelink showing your child's date of birth **PLUS** a Statutory Declaration witnessed by a Justice of the Peace as proof of your child's age. Your child's enrolment will not be complete until we have these documents.

Prep orientation sessions for the new preps and parents/caregivers will be offered on Friday 16, 23 and 30 November, from 9-11am each day. You are welcome to come to one session or all sessions. Sessions will be held in the Prep Building with Mrs Julie Mayers, come and see what your child will experience when they start in 2019. We hope to see you there! This is a great opportunity for the teacher to get to know your child.
