This funding will be used to

- Maintain the whole school Reading Strategy through consistency in Literacy Block practice across the school.
- Implement the whole school Writing Strategy to increase the % of students achieving C or higher in English.

Our initiatives include

- Further develop and implement the Case Management process that supports improved achievements by building teacher capacity to plan, implement and monitor targeted and focused interventions.
- Implement Whole School Reading and Writing Strategies to improve NAPLAN Reading and Writing results in Years 3 and 5.
- Develop and implement a Whole School approach to the teaching of Writing (aligned to, and including engagement with the “Seven Steps to Writing” by Jen McVeity and ‘The Writing Revolution’ by Judith Hochman and Natalie Wexler).
- Enhance staff data literacy skills to continue to build teacher capacity to track student progress, identify next steps for teaching and reflect on the effectiveness of their teaching practice (Sharrat, L & Fullan, M. 2012 Putting *FACES* on the Data: What Great Leaders do!; Kaser, L & Halbert, J. 2017 The Spiral of Inquiry: Leading with an inquiring mindset in school systems and schools).
- Develop and implement a Whole School approach to student goal setting and feedback.
