Under this agreement for 2022 Redbank State School will receive

\$163,198*

This funding will be used to

- To fund an Inclusion Coach (0.6 FTE) to support staff with building capability in how to plan, teach, assess a differentiated and inclusive curriculum.
- To extend teacher aide time to support student learning and engagement within the classroom.
- To ensure the percentage of students achieving 85% at or above benchmark in English through focused A-E data discussions and moderation sessions.

Our initiatives include

- Teachers provided with release time each term to collaborate with Principal and Inclusion Coach in Focussed Data discussions, M1 – M4 moderation and Student Case Mangament to analyse student data and plan next steps for teaching and learning leading to improved student outcomes.
- Teachers participating in collaborative curriculum planning sessions and scheduled moderation sessions in school and across cluster schools to deepen their understanding of learning intentions, success criteria and the curriculum standards on which student assesment is based.
- Teachers participating in scheduled professional development sessions and collaborative planning sessions to build capability in how to plan, teach and assess and record adjustments for students with disabilities and learning support requirements (Nationally Consistent Collection of Data).
- Targeted professional development using high yield pedagogical approaches will be provided to staff to support student engagement and learning outcomes; Teach Like a Champion (Lemov), Explicit Instruction (Archer & Hughes), The Differentiated Curriculum (Tomlinson), Visible Learning for Literacy (Fisher, Frey & Hattie).
- Extending teacher aide allocation to support student engagement and outcomes aligned to the school's inclusive approach to teaching and learning.
